



Important Information You Need to Know About the Data!

Use the data on the lists at your own risk. It can be incredibly helpful but you need to keep in mind two very important things.

The first is that it contains errors! Not all schools bother to check and correct their data. If something doesn't look right, it may not be.

The second is that it's based on averages. People are quick to tell me when they know someone who received great financial aid from a school with a red indicator. I think that's wonderful for the student and her family. That doesn't change the fact that the college's average award for the students with family incomes less than \$30,000 was over \$20,000.

I'm including some of the more important information below. However, be sure to read the notes at the end of the list for a complete explanation of the data.

Best Bets N	Meets need indicator. Yes, some students will receive generous need aid at schools with red indicators and some won't receive any at those with green indicators. This has to do with averages.
4 Year Graduation Rate	This number could be wrong. If the colleges don't correct the information, the Department of Education publishes the data as is. It also could be low because a high percentage of students are involved in cooperative programs or are engineering majors.
Test Scores	Not all schools report their test scores although they will report % taking the test.
%	This is the percentage of students reporting their scores. If the number is low, you shouldn't use it as a general guide to average 75 th % scores for the test.
Average Endowment Per Student	This is for full-time equivalent undergraduates. Some this useful when looking for financial stability.
Average Net Price	Schools with lower average net prices, especially under \$30,000 are probably providing more significant financial aid. As the average passes \$30,000, schools may still be providing aid, but not as much. For public schools, this number applies only to students receiving in-state tuition.

Average Net Price is for in-state students only at public institutions.

* Percent of freshman submitting SAT scores

**Gift aid refers to any aid that does not require repayment. It may be merit based or need based aid (from the government and/or the institution).

Best Bets for Meeting Need

- Green Square-Most generous need based aid. Meets at least 90% of need or average net price is under \$10,000 for students in lowest income category.
- Empty Square-Students may receive some need based aid but not on a predictable basis.
- Red Square-Poor indicators for need based aid.
